Foreign Trade Regulations (FTR) Changes

Advanced Export Information (AEI) Pilot Program

- **Federal Register Notice Published January 31, 2014**
- **Over 80 Applications received**
- **Since October, there have been about 1,000 shipments**
- **Program Assessment**

Advanced Export Information (AEI) Pilot Program

Mandatory Data Elements

1. **USPPI and USPPI identification**
2. **Ultimate consignee**
3. **Commodity classification number**
4. **Commodity description**
5. **Port of export**
6. **Date of export**
7. **Carrier identification**
8. **Conveyance name/carrier name**
9. **License code/license exemption code**
10. **Shipment reference number**

Conditional Data Elements

1. **Authorized agent's identification number (if an authorized agent is used to prepare and file the EEI)**
2. **Export Control Classification Number**

AESDirect into ACE

Background

- *AESDirect* will be accessible through CBP/ACE platform
- Legacy *AESDirect* and ACE *AESDirect* will run in parallel during the transition
- To use *AESDirect* on the ACE platform, filers must setup an ACE Exporter Account

Transition Dates

Target Date	Milestone
Summer 2015	Export Accounts
Summer 2015	Exporters can request access to export reports after creating an exporter account.
Fall 2015	The AESDirect web portal available in ACE.
Early 2016	Remaining AESDirect functionality to include EDI upload and weblink in ACE.
TBD 2016	Transition & Sunset legacy <i>AESDirect</i>
