- **FMC Commissioner Dan Maffei** served under Republican and Democratic Presidents. He'll listen to what ag shippers need and what Commissioners need to know.
- **Rich Roche, Mohawk Global Shipper Advocate at the FMC:** How to fight demurrage+detention charges, effectively pursue a complaint to the FMC?

Experts lead off-the-record, free-wheeling discussion, vent, share, strategize (no speeches!).

- Congress is Amending OSRA2022 – Our priorities? Demurrage/detention, chassis availability.
- Headaches. Your export arrives but seal is broken? What else?
